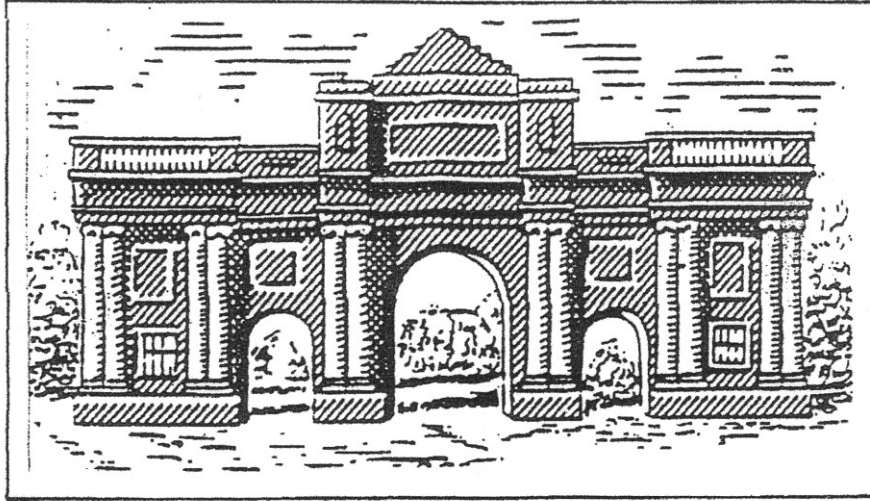

**Proposed amendments/corrections to the minutes:**

3 (a): 19 (not 90 Ashville Road); 3(d): support for the WHS bid has already been obtained from the Mayor of the Liverpool City Region; 3 (f): Park Road South plots = 54/56 PRS – planning permission was granted over a year ago (despite national opposition) – the exclusivity clause refers to a failed attempt by the developer to sell on part of his interest in the site.
